

Bill Walsh: Leukemia

Without a known birth time, here's what I find interesting about Walsh's horoscope (born November 30, 1931 in Los Angeles, CA):

I think the precise natal square between Neptune (7 Vir 57) and his Sun (at 7 Sag 24) seems quite important. As well, it's interesting to track Solar Arc Mars over the past 4 years: SA Mars=Saturn (2003), SA Mars=Pluto (when diagnosed in 2004 with tr. Saturn conjunct Pluto), and in 2005 we see SA Mars square the Sun, and opposed Neptune (Mars=Sun; Mars=Neptune).

What also seems very significant is the triple natal conjunction of Mars-Mercury-Venus (in Sagittarius). Transiting Neptune was semisquare this conjunction (from 2001 throughout 2004), transiting Saturn was opposed this conjunction (as well as opposing the Sun and Neptune) in 2002/2003, and finally transiting Pluto was conjunct the planetary trio in 2005 (along with tr. Saturn conjunct Pluto)!

For example, if he were born with a Taurus Ascendant (ruled by Venus), that would place Aries on the 12th house cusp with Mars ruling that house. That would support the strong Solar Arc pictures involving Mars since 2003.

Or perhaps a Gemini Ascendant (ruled by Mercury) with Taurus on the 12th house cusp (ruled by Venus), or a possible Libra Ascendant with Virgo on the 12th house cusp.

Those combinations would make sense to me after seeing the astrological activity since 2001 (3 years prior to diagnosis) involving natal Mars-Mercury-Venus. That's where I'd logically start with rectifying his birth time.

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
